Her novel "The Etymology of blood" was awarded with the International Ukraine-German Prize "Oles Honchar", "Coronation words" Prize and the Prize of the edition "Smoloskyp" (Kyiv). Her poems have been translated in several languages. She is the member of the National Writers Union of Ukraine and of the Ukrainian Writers Association. She lives in Kyiv, Ukraine.
